



Your child has completed the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) for his/her enrolled grade level. The Texas Education Agency (TEA) adjusted the state testing calendar to shift STAAR 3-8 testing to the month of May. As a result, scores will not be available until school is out in the summer.

Beginning on Thursday, June 30, 2016, parents may view their child's 2016 STAAR 3-8 test results using the state Student Portal.

In order to access your child's scores, please complete the following steps:

1. In your preferred browser, type www.cfisd.net
2. Click Parents and Students
3. Click Home Access Center-Grades
4. Sign into Home Access Center
5. Click on the School Links Tab
6. Click on State Testing Portal
7. Locate & write down the Unique Access Code
8. Click on the Link to take you to the Student Portal or enter www.texasassessment.com/students
9. Type in your child's Unique Access Code.
10. Enter in your child's birth date.
11. Once logged in, you will be able to review all available test results.

The information in the Texas Assessment Data Portal is an official record of state testing scores. Parents and Guardians can submit this page to other educational institutions when state testing scores are requested.

Your child's campus for the 2016-2017 school year will send home the Confidential Student Reports (CSRs) at the beginning of the new school year.
